Explore different kinds of shapes.



What You'll Need

- Magazines, newspapers, or mail
- Construction paper
- Scissors
- Glue stick or tape

Steps



Denotes a step that may require adult support.

- 1. Look for shapes!** Look through magazines, newspapers, and mail to cut out various shapes, like circles, squares, or triangles!
- 2. Make shapes!** You can also use construction paper to make and cut out your own shapes.
- 3. Talk about it!** Talk about each shape's characteristics (number of sides, corners, curved, straight).
- 4. Create a shapes collage!** Glue the shapes to a piece of paper to create a shapes collage of a character, scene, or an animal.
