

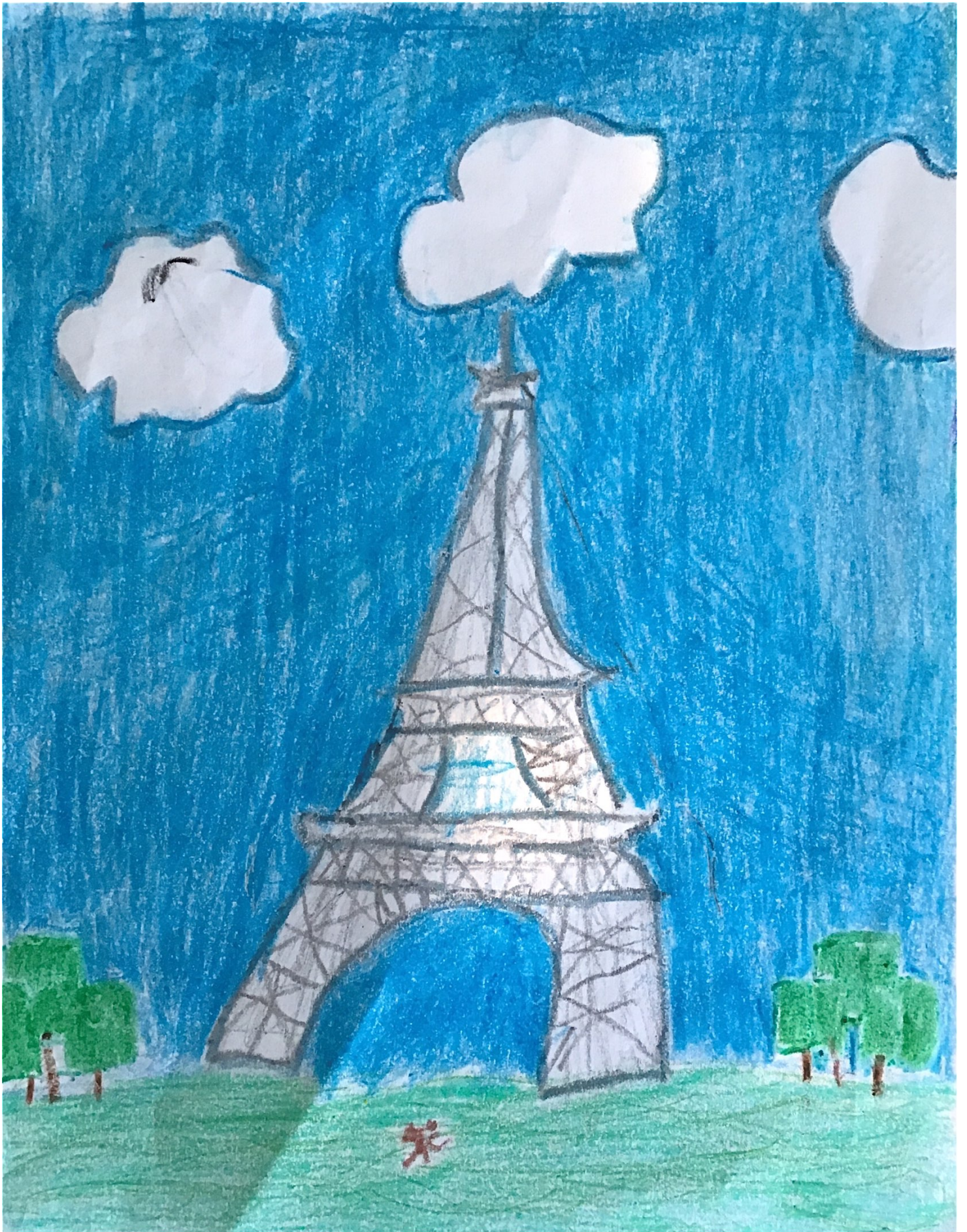
Where did Mossy
